It would be very helpful if we could have your mobile phone number to keep on your record. This is very useful if we need to contact you for any reason, such as having to cancel an appointment you have, and any messages the doctor wants to give you. If you are happy for us to have your mobile number, please let the reception staff know and they will attach it to your record.

APPOINTMENTS

Our appointments system is run on a bookable only basis. We do not hold any "sit and wait surgeries".We do run early morning surgeries on **Friday mornings from 7.30am** and late evening surgeries on **Monday evenings up to 7.30 pm** for the convenience of patients who find it hard to get to the surgery during working hours.

We also offer telephone appointments to save patients having to come to the surgery. These do prove very useful if your problem can be dealt with without the need to actually be seen. Please ask reception for a telephone appointment and you will be given a time when the doctor will ring you. Please note that sometimes the doctor is unable to ring at the specified time owing to their surgery over running with extra urgent patients needing to be seen. However the doctor will always ring patients who have telephone appointments booked so please bear with them.

<u>ACCESS TO THE</u> <u>SURGERY</u>

Some patients who are wheelchair bound have expressed difficulty in getting into the surgery due to the 2 doors. If you do require help please use the intercom just next to the outside door and a member of staff will be happy to assist you.
