Introduction

What a year we have had so far. There have been many changes in the way we are having to work at the surgery due to the Covid19 pandemic. When you next attend the practice you will notice screens up on our reception desk to offer both yourself and our reception team peace of mind. Currently you will be asked to wait at the door on arrival where a member of reception will take you name and inform the clinical staff you have arrived. You will be collected by your nurse or doctor who will invite you in to the practice and ask you to wear a face mask and sanitize your hands.

All appointments need to be booked over the telephone and should you wish to see a doctor this will initial be a telephone triage call with a GP who will then invite you down to the surgery if necessary at an allotted time. You may be asked to supply us with a photograph of the problem you wish to discuss, if so you will be given a secure method for sending this information to us.

E-Consults

(An alternative to a GP telephone call)

We are also encouraging you to fill in an econsult via our web site where possible giving us as much information as possible and then the appropriate person will contact you with 48 hours either via email or telephone.

What can I use an e-consult for? Sick note requests, travel/immunisation requests, medical report requests, hypertension reviews and general illnesses

This is a simple process where you choose the appropriate link and then answer all the questions.

Prescription Requests

We ask that you either register for online medication ordering via Systm1 online or fill in your green prescription slip or put your details and medication request on a piece of paper and post it through our external letter box in person or via a third party or send via royal mail.

Mobile Phones

Did you know if you register your mobile phone number with us we can text you to remind you of your appointments and also send through test results and other important messages?

Annual Health Recalls

Pneumococcal Vaccine

All patients over the age of 65 are eligible for a FREE Pneumococcal vaccine. This is a very important vaccine. There has never been a more important time to keep on top of your immunisations. Therefore if you have not yet had your vaccine, please contact reception to book an appointment

NHS Health Checks

NHS Health checks are being offered to people aged between 40 and 74 once every five years on a rolling programme which will be starting by targeting those most at risk of developing certain conditions. The risk can be due to genetics, lifestyle choices or sometimes certain types of medication can affect your health, for example, by making you put on weight. As the programme develops everyone between 40 and 74 – apart from people already receiving treatment for a long term condition - will be invited for a health check. The check is to assess your risk of developing heart disease, stroke, kidney disease or diabetes. If there are any warnings signs, then together we can do something about it. By taking early action, can improve your health and prevent the onset of these conditions.
